

It's Time for Your Flu Shot



Dear Member,

The flu is very contagious and can be a serious threat against your health, especially if you are 65 or older, or have:

- Obesity
- Lung disease
- Heart disease
- A weakened immune system
- Diabetes, liver or kidney disease

The cost of the flu shot is covered by Family Health Network. Adults age 19 or older can go to their medical provider's office or any in-network pharmacy (with a prescription) that offers flu shots at their retail location.
